3.1	 Q. Will the Worcester County consider on site dewatering of the material in Unit #4 as a method of removal? If so, would the county consider extending the project time frame to accommodate on site dewatering? A. Yes, dewatering will be considered as a possible solution. The County has extended the timeline for completion to 10 working days. 			
3.2	Q. Is there 480 3 phase 100 AMP power available onsite? A. Yes.			

3.3	Q. What will be the total volume of waste (Sludge, Grit) to be removed from the Unit 4 Tank? A. The total volume of waste is unknown. Since the pre-bid meeting we have been able to install one new mixer in the second anoxic chamber which has dropped the sludge/grit dramatically. We are estimating approximately 3' at the bottom may contain grit.
3.4	Q. Can we pump out all the sludge back to the plant (Digesters, Lagoon) leaving all the grit behind in Unit 4 to be removed mechanically?A. Yes, sludge can be diverted to the digesters and grit can remain in Unit 4 to be removed mechanically. The Successful Vendor is to minimize as much solids as possible to be placed into the lagoon.
3.5	Q. Can you provide the capacity for the digesters and lagoon that will be available to the contractor during this project?A. Digesters volume according to our records is 500,000gal and the emergency lagoon has a capacity of 2.3 Million Gallons.
3.6	Q. Will it be possible to change the completion time from 5 working days to 10 working days?A. Yes, so long that it has been understood that working days means continuous work as this tank is critical to operational capacity.
3.7	Q. Do we need to provide a Skid-Steer to push the grit into the drying beds?A. Yes, the Successful Vendor is to provide equipment to manipulate material into the drying beds.
3.8	Q. Will polymer if needed be provided by the owner? A. Yes, the County will provide polymer.
3.9	 Q. What is the hydrant size and working pressure available for this project? A. Standard Hydrant is available with 6" main has a 5 1/4" connection and one blow off hydrant with 2 1/2" connection approximately 55-62psi.
3.10	Q. Will the Unit 4 Tank need to be power washed?A. No, we do not want the interior of the tank power washed. We want the interior of the tank to be washed down utilizing the onsite hydrants.
3.11	Q. Can Unit 4 Tank be isolated? A. Yes, Unit 4 Tank can be isolated. All flow will be diverted to the emergency storage lagoon.
